VCCAC had a goal of purchasing 200 bus passes to help 100 families and ten \$10 gas cards with transportation assistance. We also budgeted \$200 for temporary lodging to help 2 families who are displaced because of abuse.

**How many lives have been impacted over the last quarter?**

VCCAC has helped 5 families with transportation assistance by giving them two \$10 gas cards, which helps them attend the forensic interview, travel to mental health services and attend community resources. This year we have purchased 26 gas cards and we currently have 6 left. We had 50 one-ride bus passes left. We were given permission to donate 26 one-ride bus passes to Dayspring Women's Shelter on 6/9/22. We had one family displaced because of abuse, so we helped them with two nights in a local hotel.

**Please break down demographics of lives impacted. If not available, how are you going to work towards gathering this information?**

5 families helped were Caucasian and one family was African American. 2 families lived in Vermilion County and 4 families lived within the Danville City Limits.

Are you on track to hit your output goals as listed above? If not, what is preventing you from reaching those output goals?

We found that families had vehicles, but were unable to afford gas, so we were able to purchase more gas cards help them with fuel costs. We purchased 50 bus passes and 26 gas cards. Out of the 26 gas cards purchased, we currently have 6 left. We had 50 one-ride bus passes and were given permission to donate 26 one-ride bus passes to Dayspring Women's Shelter on 6/9/22. We still have 24 bus passes on hand. We met the goal of helping with temporary shelter.

Our agency has grown and progressed in the last year. We now have 3 staff members and expanded office space to better provide direct service to Vermilion County families. We had a projection of providing forensic interviews to 100 children and at the end of June 2022 had interviewed 122 children which met and exceeded the goal. Our Multidisciplinary Team works very well together to provide the best service to our families.

- I liked the overall environment and how nice the advocate was he gave my little siblings gifts so they were all excited but he also helped me understand the benefit of counseling so I appreciate that so much
- How nice and kind everyone was especially the advocate he gave me a tour because I was nervous and anxious and he showed me the superhero hallway and the beautiful tree with all the leaves and I just felt welcomed and less nervous about the process
- Jonathan was so nice and helpful with everything and kept me in a calm manner
- Just overall a nice process and a nice setting for any child
- The staff was so pleasant and caring
- He (law enforcement) was very respectful and I appreciate him talking to us before the interview
- She (DCFS) was so sweet and very understanding
