Our agency proposed to purchase 200 single ride bus passes, 10 gas cards worth \$10 each and hold some money for temporary shelter in case one of our families is displaced because of the abuse. In the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter, our agency found that most families have a vehicle but were struggling to afford the price of gas. We purchased 50 bus passes in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter and have not given out any to date. We have \$188.50 left for temporary shelter, but have not helped a family with shelter to date. We have purchased 26 gas cards and have given out all but 4 cards.

How many lives have been impacted over the last quarter?

We have impacted 16 families by helping them purchase fuel for their vehicles so they can attend the forensic interviews. The gas cards are given out at the interview so they could also have been used for fuel to attend mental health visits or medical visits after the interview. Some families had to come back a second time to bring other children for an interview so they could have received two gas cards, one for each visit.

Are you on track to hit your output goals as listed above? If not, what is preventing you from reaching those output goals?

Our budget will have to be modified. We expected families to use the bus passes more frequently than the gas cards and we were mistaken. We will not be able to sign out all of the bus passes before the end of the year. The temporary shelter money may or may not be spent out by the end of the year.

If we could modify, we would request the rest of the shelter money be spent on gas cards. We will do our best to assess each family's needs to see if they could use the bus passes.

One family was very grateful to receive a gas card when they came to our center for a forensic interview. The suspect in the disclosure was the main source of income for the family. The mother was unsure what to do and where to start. When she talked with Jonathan, our family advocate, he was able to give her many resources and a gas card to help. This mother then called back a couple weeks later to ask for more resources and a list of job opportunities. She thanked Jonathan again for the help and support to get her on the right track.

Another family had a similar story, except the mother only spoke Spanish. The main income source was the suspect. Jonathan is bilingual and was able to provide support and advocacy to the mother. We gave her pamphlets and resources in Spanish. She had to come to the center two different days to bring more children for interviews, so she was a family who received two gas cards. We also met with the family again to talk about referrals to mental health services and the importance of mental health for herself and her children.
